6/13/16 Meeting was called to Order approximately 7:05pm

Words from their Excellencies: Baroness Esperanza commented on this weekend was Baronial Birthday and was hoping to see everyone there.

Officer Reports:

Exchequer: Lord Grimm reported the necessary checks were written and delivered to the appropriate people. The Barony also has money. Lord Grimm also reminded everyone his warrant ends in August and will not be renewing

A&S: Lady Faolaine reported prizes have been purchased for the Baronial Birthday A&S competition. Also Fall University will be September 17, in the Barony of Dun Carraig. If anyone is interested in submitting a bid for Winter University, all bids must be submitted before Pennsic.

Chatelaine: Karl reported he has Gold Key for the event. Also HRM will not be attending and is unsure if their HRH will be attending. Karl is planning to have a newcomer's tour approximately 1-1:30.

Web Minister: Master Richard asked all officers to check their contact information on the web site and event information.

Herald: Lady Sara warrant is up in January and is looking to step down. However, with the Baronesses urging she will consider staying on.

An email was received about the Barony of Lochmere is hosting a Known World Throw Weapons Tournament at Pennsic. The Baron and Baroness will look at the possibility of choosing a Thrown Weapons Champion during Birthday to compete.

Baronial Birthday: The Autocrats report everything is in good shape. There were a few questions about equipment and who it rightfully belonged too. The Baron and Baroness will be bringing extra drink coolers, high table feast gear and other supplies. Some of the poles for the banners need repairs and are being seen too. The new Baronial Pavilion will set up between the Armored

and Rapier fields for the populace to use. Lord Grimm is supplying a day shade for Archers. Baron Mors will be getting a cake for the event. There will also be a Bardic competition during the event. There are two companies who will be vending during the event.

The autocrats request people who are interested in helping to set up on Friday June 17 no earlier than 3:30 pm.

Note from the MOAS, hats for the hat competition need to be placed on a table for judging.

Holiday Faire 2016: Lady Arnbjorg, the Autocrat, submitted a tentative budget for Holiday Faire. There were a few corrections.

It was decided, 2 table s and 2 chairs would be rented for \$20 on a pre-registration only.
