Old Business:

Baronial Birthday: Johanna and Mistress Cerwin thanked everyone for all their hard work. It made \$178.73. 150 people attended. The site coordinator Carol loves us. Special thanks to Chris of Stierbach and to the Hall Steward.

New Business:

Baronial Birthday- It still needs to be decided if we are having birthday next June or September.

June would conflict with Krazy unless we change the date. Mors and Esperanza wouldn't want to use the horse farm because it could be an investiture if they decide to step down. Johanna will check to see what dates are available for Fauquier County Fairgrounds with a preferred date of June 24th and second choice would be June 17th and third would be open date in September. Holiday Faire- (Insurance needs to be added to the budget.) The money made for this event goes to the storage lockers and other basic expenses. This uncharge would be to cover the \$300 difference for the site since the rental charge increased in price. Grimm called for a motion to increase the gate fee \$2.00 and include \$50.00 for insurance for the new budget for Holiday Faire. It was voted on and passed pending Heloise's vote.
