Words from their Excellencies:

The new baronial archery marshal is Wulff Nuremberger. Ruby Joust is next weekend (5/24-5/26) and Karin is the land agent, Stierbach is sharing space with Ponte Alto. List field space will also be shared with Ponte Alto. For Pennsic, the land agent is Allen of Wolfhou and he needs tent sizes with and without ropes, style, and number of campers in tent. There are less than 75 days remaining. We will have list field space available at Highland River Melees. Crown was wonderful, beautiful day. Pennsic deadlines are May 31 for mail in pre-registration and June 19 online.

Officer Reports:

Webminister: (Master Richard) The photo gallery has been moved, there is now a pdf reader built in, but found no simple blog set ups. A work-around was found by using the category: blog. The most recent 3 entries will appear on the page.

Herald: (Lord James) Helped someone from Ponte Alto with a re-submission.

Steward: (Lady Johanna) is heading to Coopers on Friday to check on the trailer and will need a check in July for Pennsic storage.

Exchequer: (Mistress Ceridwyen) Equestrian insurance in progress, monthly totals will be available at a later date. Lord Adelric requested a copy of insurance and will go ahead and procure ABC license on a reimbursement basis.

Chronicler: (Lady Isobel) Newsletter went out, month's events and opportunities published via a facebook note on the official page, will start putting a copy on the blog once credentials received.

Seneschal: (Duchess Esa) The barony was approached to co-host and handle the money side of the melee and authorization event, which takes place two weeks before Pennsic. A discussion followed about the short timing and needs for authorizations. It was determined that we would help them try to procure an authorization exception only and that future requests to co-host an event would require at least a 4 month notice.

Knight Marshal: (Sir Ragnarr Rifbrjótr) Bringing armor to the workshop day on 5/18 at Aine and Sigurd's and looking at practices on Wednesday Scribal night at Mors and Esperanza's.

Chatelain: (Lord Karl the Mead Drinker) We had two dozen referrals from Awesome Con and demos, lots of folks returning to the SCA.

New Business:

12th Night bid 2020- Baroness Aine is tabling efforts to pursue the bid for next year.

Spring Coronation 4/4/2020- Baroness Arnbjörg not present for discussion.

Old Business:

Wakefield Demo: (Baroness Aine) Wakefield Demo is next Tuesday at 2 pm, 5/21, show up at 1:30 pm. There will be multiple grade levels (K-12), demo has taken place for 20 years now. We currently have 1 rapier, 1 heavy fighter right now plus Failenn and Blitha. The other potential demo in June was cancelled from our end.

Baronial Birthday 2019- Autocrat Lord Adelric said the chatelaine position has been filled and Johanna de Bletsho volunteered to do site tokens and ideas are welcome. Still need an event herald, parking reeve, MOL, servers, set up and tear down volunteers. At Defending the Gate, the kitchen staff needed more help, so we are looking for 3-4 dish washers. It was determined that the extra fees charged for the site during Defending the Gate were due to additional time during set up. ABC license is in progress, Spike will be updated after the website is updated. Silent auction items should go to Master Richard. A lunch fundraiser group is still available, the only requirement is that you have to state where the money is going. The initial draft of the schedule is on the website, we still have a July 9 meeting planning deadline.

There was a request to move up court and feast so that the clean-up crew would not be on site so late.

Holiday Faire 2019- Autocrat Baroness Arnbjörg not present, so discussion postponed.

Name: Lord Ulfarr Refskegg, Canton of Sudentorre, Barony of Stierbach

Blazen: Per bend gules and purple, a bend cotised between a sheaf of arrows bendwise and a sword bendwise argent

How long have you played in the SCA? 10 years

How did you discover the SCA?

My first experience with the SCA was a week long after school program run by the SCA when I was in 5th grade. I loved the experience and remember it to this day. However, I didn't rediscover the SCA until my girlfriend (who is now my wife) convinced me to come to a Sunday meeting at castle Wolfhou. She convinced me to come by telling me that there would be archery there.

What do you wish you had known as a newcomer?

Wolfhou was a wonderful place to be a newcomer. They are very welcoming, and do a great job of helping people find their "thing"...or "things". However, when I first started at Wolfhou, there was no rapier. I started off in the SCA primarily doing archery and bardic. It was not until almost a year later that I discovered the endless joy of SCA heavy rapier. I have made it my mission to make sure that ALL newcomers I meet know about SCA rapier!

Can you give an example of a skill you have developed in the SCA?

I improved my archery skills, and I have improved my skill with rapier as well. However, in addition I have also improved my teaching and leadership skills.

How about a mundane skill that you have brought to your SCA experience?



I am a trained singer and actor, and spent several years doing both as my primary way of making a living. I was able to apply these skills to bardic performance. They were of great help during my two years as Stierbach's baronial bardic champion. I also had ten years of Olympic style fencing experience prior to joining the SCA. This was very valuable as a new rapier fighter.

Describe a time when "the dream" came alive for you.

My first Pennsic in general. I "came home" for the first time. I will never forget my first open field battle at Pennsic. There were hundreds of fighters on each side. As I was charging forward toward the enemy, the mundane world no longer existed. I was living "the dream"!
