When I was in high school my best friend's two sisters were involved in the SCA. I would go to their house for

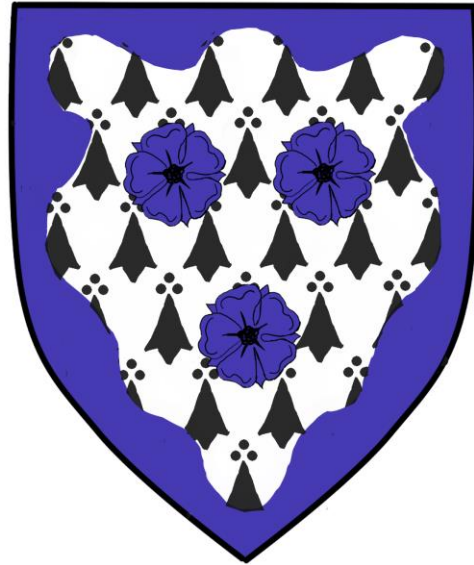
