Officer Reports:

Seneschal: (At the time of the meeting) we are still phase o, with 3 baronies now closed. (This has since changed to Stierbach now being closed per the Kingdom's guidelines.)

A&S: A&S nights are still in stasis. (Winter University class submissions are due December 11th.)

Exchequer: Account signatures are still not updated, the bank is not returning calls. The quarterly report was filed with approximately \$29k for general use and approximately \$7-8k allocated use, e.g. archery, camping. The barony did make \$32 from the cancelled spring crown tourney thanks to a donated ticket refund.

Herald: Nothing new to report.

Knights Marshall: no official practices, entrants will need to wear masks for the next crown tourney.

Chronicler: Isobel will be stepping down to accept a chronicler position with the the Kingdom of Atlantia Royal Forestry Guild. Deputy Jenefer will be stepping in and taking over the social media deputy position as well. Web Minister: Nothing to report on the web site, a silent auction donation was received from Steve Sheets.

Trailer taxes are still in progress and it remains in Duchess Esa's name. A not to exceed cost of \$50 was approved.
