Baron Wulff and Baroness Genefe are seeking donations for a gift basket to present to the new Heirs at Crown Tournament. Also seeking contributions for a gift for the new Storvik Thanos.

Officer Reports:

Seneschal: Covid Safer Policy implemented Kingdom wide effective 10/18/21 with an end date of 3/12/22 or earlier if all groups reach an 80% vaccination rate.

Exchequer: Final report for Baronial Birthday submitted to Kingdom. The Baronial Birthday event netted a profit of \$1300, and the silent auction netted a profit of \$500. 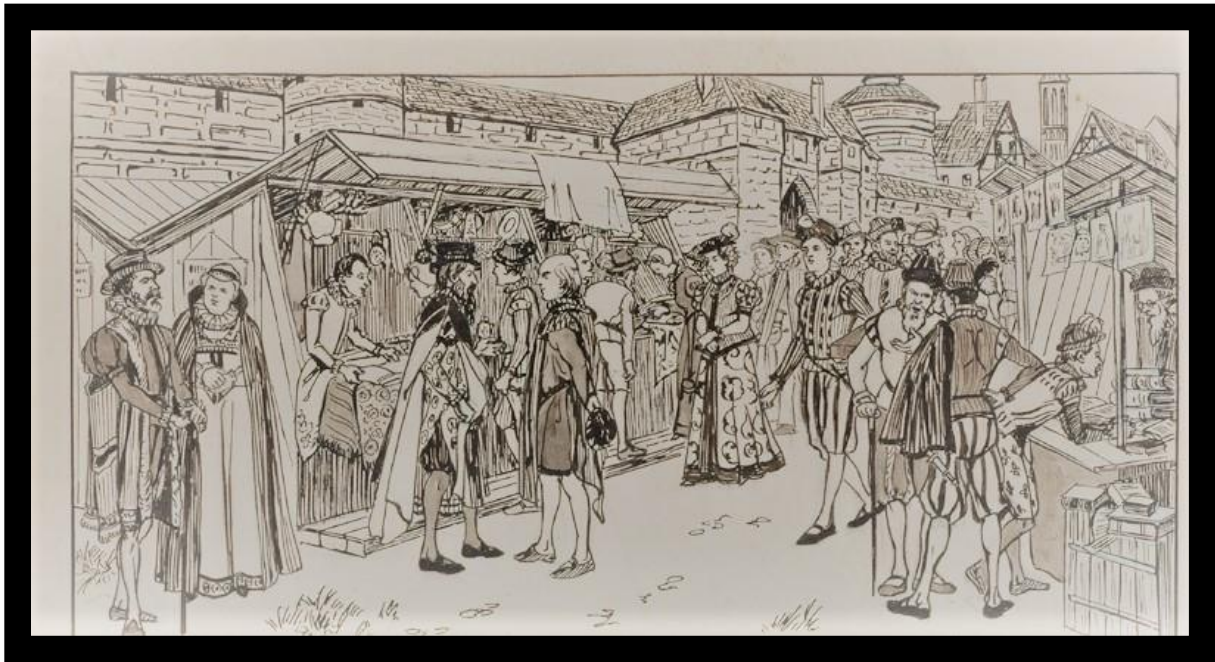
