☞ Baronial Business Meeting Notes: December 14th ☞

Meeting called to order at 7:04 pm by Seneschal, Master Sigurd Ericsson.

Words from their Excellencies:

Baron Wulff sent greetings. They need retainers for Twelfth Night. Please, as always, submit award recommendations!

Officer Reports:

Seneschal: Good job on Holiday Faire to all involved. Lord Aldelric Falke will be stepping up as new Seneschal for Stierbach when Sigurd's term ends.

Exchequer: Still reconciling final report for Holiday Faire. Thus far we appear to have made a \$4,000.00 profit, with over 500 attendees. Also still reconciling attendees with SCARS. Profit does not include the \$714.00 made in the Silent Auction. We need to consider what to do with this profit, possibly donate to the Kingdom Travel Fund, or a donation to our Canton of Sudentorre. Lord Dunstan Stonehill's warrant for Exchequer has been approved. Cerwidwen and Dunstan will work together on the year end report. The Kingdom has switched to Citizens Bank. Suggest Stierbach consider switching as well considering our issues with Wells Fargo. Cerwidwen proposed switching

half our funds to Citizens Bank, allowing time to close out everything with Wells Fargo. No objections from officers or populace. MOTION: Transfer \$10,000.00 to Citizens Bank to open account. Motion approved. Prior to Business Meeting officers approved \$596.00 for storage locker fee, and \$100.00 for chairs for Holiday Faire. Need approval for the following expenditures:

\$36.23 – Property Tax

\$8.00 – Insurance

A total of \$44.23 was approved for these expenditures. Report from Unevent: We need a revised draft of our financial policy, due to Kingdom by 12/31/21.

Webminister: Not much to report. New photos are on the website. Kingdom is working on email solution.

Herald: No new updates. Still looking for a replacement.

Knight's Marshal: Submitted No Waiver Report. Attended Unevent, renewed marshalate warrant.

MOL: Welcome Banbharun Briana Morgan of the Valley as Stierbach's new Minister of the Lists.

A&S: From Unevent: Kingdom has decided to revive The Oak – A&S related publication. University is in February. Current warrant is up in January, Lady Cynthia Anne of Silver Lakes will be stepping up as Stierbach's MOAS.

Chatelaine: We had 17 who needed Gold Key at Holiday Faire. From Unevent: Kingdom is switching gears to focus on retaining members.

Chronicler: Newsletter went out. Always seeking submissions! From

Unevent: The New Spike version 3.0 to be released soon. Once 3.0 is up and running there will be only one form to submit, eliminating the current process of event listing, then flyer. The term "autocrat" is going away, "event steward" will be used in its place. Kingdom Chronicler has new deputies: Digital Deputy (formerly Web Deputy), Warrant Deputy, Waiver/Release Deputy.

Social Media: From Unevent: Warrants are required for all Social Media deputies. Anti-bullying Policy, screenshot any bullying – offender can be sanctioned if occurs on official pages. This also applies to personal profiles with an SCA connection. Merchants cannot post ads on official pages. Kingdom Social Media Deputy must be made an Administrator on all Baronial pages. Currently looking for a Deputy for Virtual Atlantia. Content Deputies are needed for Instagram, TikTok, and Twitter. Unofficial practices cannot be posted on official pages.

Old Business:

Holiday Faire: Mistress Aine ingen Chuimin reported this is the largest attendance Holiday Faire has had. Thank you to staff for going above and beyond, staff was the best. Final event report will be filed soon. Once incident occurred at the end of the event, will be disclosed to officers in the report. Willing to look over new site contract in preparation for next year.

Spring Crown Tournament: Lord Adelic Falke reported he has two deputy event stewards: Lord Johannes Reinhardt von Falkenstein and Bonny Daniels. A copy of the signed contract

has been submitted and the site has been paid. Site tokens are complete, website is up, SCARS is open and will close on 5/4/22. Submitted paperwork for ABC license. License cost increased to \$85.00. There are some increased costs due to COVID, will see if budget needs to be adjusted. Need volunteers for gate, and additional staff, will be making a post to solicit.

Defending the Gate: Lord Adelric Falke reported SCARS is open, there are 70 feast slots available.

Lady Mariana of Ponte Alto approached the populace requesting assistance for Ponte Alto's event Tournament of Love and Beauty to be held in February. They are seeking assistance in the form of staffing and general help. Populace discussed and agreed to assist once they see the event is Spiked.
